

How to get there:

By Car Seagrave is 15 minutes off the M1 Junction 21a. Take the A46 outer ring road , until you reach a roundabout turn left (North) towards A46 Newark. After Ratcliffe College, turn left signpost Seagrave, On entering the village take the third right Green Lane. The Village hall is past the school on the left.

By Train Trains from London St Pancras run approximately every half hour to Leicester or less frequently to Loughborough. From other areas times can be found on the <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/> website or via 08457 48 49 50 telephone service. It may be worth checking trains to Melton from some areas. From Leicester or Loughborough Train Stations take the train to Sileby, which is 2 miles from Seagrave and call for a lift. Or the local bus runs ever hour to just outside our door from the station.

By Coach There are frequent coaches to Leicester from most large cities. <http://www.nationalexpress.com/home/hp.cfm> 08705 808080

By boat The River Soar runs through Leicester and mooring can be found locally at Sileby Marina. Then call for a lift.
